The NESD believes in Engaging and Empowering Learners

- Students and teachers are using Edsby tools to collect, curate and upload evidence of their learning into **Gradebook, Learning Story** or **Portfolio**.
- **Reflective documentation engages the learner with increasing agency and independence in interactive dialogue, next steps, or feedback with peers, teachers and/or parents.**

Communicating Growth with Families

- Report cards will communicate progress specific to academic focus areas.
- Conversations about **academic growth and next steps** in learning (formerly report card comments) will be communicated using Edsby tools to provide on-going, *responsive and timely* feedback.
- **Personal and social development will not be reported in 2025-26.** Where necessary, teachers will share insights on student's non-academic growth and development in a responsive and timely fashion via phone, learning story or Edsby direct messaging.
- You will notice learning conversations will happen in a variety of formats: *Gradebook Evidence, Learning Story*, messages, phone calls, in-person and student led conferences.
- **For students with an IIP**, comments about learning are provided in OurSTUDENTS IIP Term Progress Reports.
