The Saskatchewan School Boards Association (SSBA) is a non-profit organization dedicated to excellence in public education by providing leadership services to Saskatchewan school boards. The Association represents school boards in Saskatchewan.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Membership and Participation

- a. The Board endorses full active membership in the Association through its payment of the annual fee to the SSBA.
- b. The Board supports the active participation of its trustee membership in the Association.
- c. The Board establishes a remuneration and expense schedule in accordance with Board Policy No. 104 to recognize expenses incurred by Board members attending SSBA sponsored meetings, seminars, workshops, and conventions.

2. SSBA Voting Delegates

- a. The Board is to determine, as required, which of the trustees delegated to Convention are voting delegates.
- b. The Board is to apportion in whole numbers, its number of votes among those voting delegates in accordance with SSBA Bylaws 10: General Assemblies and 11: Delegates and Voting. Each trustee attending is to be a voting delegate apportioned at least one vote.
- c. Any votes remaining are to be divided as equally as possible using whole numbers among the trustee members of the Board attending convention.
- d. When registering delegates, the SSBA is to be informed of the voting delegates and the number of votes apportioned each delegate.
