North East School Division Staff;

The Government of Saskatchewan outlined new measures in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The following measures are effective as of Tuesday, March 17, 2020:

- Pre-K — Grade 12 classes will wind down Tuesday through Thursday;
- Staff will report to work as usual until Friday March 20, 2020;
- Risk to staff and students in Saskatchewan remains low;
- Effective March 20, 2020 schools will be closed indefinitely.

Between now and Friday, March 20, 2020 the North East School Division will be working with the Response and Planning Team created by the Ministry of Education to ensure that staff are cared for at this uncertain time. We expect further direction and clarification on job duties and responsibilities during the period of school closure before the end of this week.

Over the coming days our school division will work with the Ministry of Education to clarify supports or opportunities for students and staff during the time of school closure.

We know that this is a time of uncertainty for our staff. We will continue to be in contact with all employees in the coming days and weeks.
