DISTANCE LEARNING

The North East School Division (NESD) encourages students to participate in face-to-face instruction. However, in some circumstances it may be beneficial and necessary for students to enroll in distance learning.

DEFINITIONS:

Part-time Online Students – Refers to Gr. 10-12 students whose intent is to take most of their course credits face to face and are registered as a primary student to a NESD school.

Full-time Online Students – Refers to K-12 students whose intent is to take their courses online and are registered as a primary student to an on-line learning provider.

PROCEDURES:

- 1. Part-time online students:
 - a. Students interested in taking online courses are to do so in consultation with their school principal or designate.
 - b. The school principal or designate will oversee course approvals, registration and monitoring of online students in accordance with the <u>NESD Distance Learning Handbook</u> and the <u>Quality</u> <u>Assurance Framework for K-12 Online Learning, 2023</u>.
- 2. Full-time online students:
 - a. NESD students can enroll full-time with any provincially approved online provider.
 - b. Full-time online students enrolled with the SaskDLC and approved catholic, or francophone online schools are permitted access to the following NESD services within their attendance area:
 - i. Educational resources, such as libraries, provided they do not interfere with schoolbased operations.
 - ii. Driver education
 - iii. Extracurricular activities provided:
 - 1. Participation adheres to school-based extra-curricular processes and expectations.
 - 2. Participation fees and travel costs are borne by the parent.
 - 3. Participation in any extracurricular activity can be ended at the discretion of the principal.
 - iv. Graduation Ceremony provided:
 - 1. Notification to participate in the graduation ceremony is made to the school principal at least 45 days prior to the graduation date.



- 2. Participation is approved by the principal in consultation with their Superintendent of Learning.
- 3. Eligibility for school scholarships is not permitted.
