STUDENT CONDUCT

The Board of Education expects that student conduct on school buses is to be consistent with that expected of the student in the classroom.

PROCEDURES

1. Posting of Rules

- a. Rules are to be posted by the driver in each bus.
- b. Rules are to be developed by the Manager of Transportation.

2. Failing to Abide by Rules

- a. The school bus driver does not have the authority to refuse bus transportation to a student who fails to abide by the rules, or who misbehaves on a bus.
- b. Subsequent to consultation with the driver, the principal may suspend a student from riding the bus for up to three (3) days per incident. The first day of the suspension is to be the school day following the day the student and parent or guardian are informed of the suspension.
- c. The Principal is to immediately inform the Supervisor of Transportation of the action taken.
- d. In the event the principal recommends a suspension exceeding three (3) days, the Director of Education, or designate will decide on appropriate action to be taken in accordance with <u>Administrative Procedure 409 Discipline</u>.
